







# QUICK USER GUIDE

## G-One / GEKKO / OCTO+ / CHAMELEON REPEATER / CHAMELEON DISPLAY

FIRE CONDITION	FAULT CONDITION
<p><b>Indications:</b></p>  <p>The <b>FIRE</b> LED will be illuminated in the <b>Status</b> section of the control panel.</p> <p>In the <b>Zones</b> section the LED(s) will be illuminated to indicate which zone or zones are in alarm. The control panel LCD display will also provide additional alarm information.</p> <p>The control panel buzzer will sound continuously.</p>  <p>Within the <b>Controls</b> section on the control panel the <b>BUZZER SILENCE</b> and <b>SOUNDERS ACTIVATE/SILENCE</b> LEDs will be illuminated.</p> <p><b>User Action:</b></p>  <p>Using the <b>KEYPAD</b> enter the level 1 access code followed by <b>ENTER</b>.</p> <p><b>Do not</b> press the <b>SYSTEM RESET</b> control button.</p> <p>Press <b>ESC</b> to view the alarm details on the LCD display.</p> <p>After confirming that the fire incident is under control and all occupants within the building have been safely evacuated, press the <b>SOUNDERS ACTIVATE/SILENCE</b> button to cancel the evacuation procedure.</p> <p>If a further <b>FIRE</b> incident is reported press the <b>SOUNDERS ACTIVATE/SILENCE</b> button again to reinstate the evacuation of the building.</p> <p>After recording all the details in the Fire Log Book, the system can be reset by pressing the <b>SYSTEM RESET</b> button.</p> <p><b>Important:</b> When logged in to access level 1 the <b>SOUNDER ACTIVATE/SILENCE</b> button can be used to manually evacuate the building.</p>	<p><b>Indications:</b></p>  <p>When a system fault occurs the control panel LCD will display the fault information.</p> <p>The <b>FAULT</b> LED will be illuminated in the <b>Status</b> section of the control panel.</p> <p>The control panel buzzer will sound periodically every 5 seconds.</p>  <p>The <b>FAULT</b> type will be indicated by a flashing LED in the <b>Faults</b> section of the control panel.</p> <p><b>User Action:</b></p>  <p>Using the <b>KEYPAD</b> enter the level 1 access code followed by <b>ENTER</b>.</p> <p>Press <b>BUZZER SILENCE</b> control button.</p> <p><b>Do not</b> press the <b>SYSTEM RESET</b> control button.</p> <p>Press the <b>ESC</b> button on the keypad to view the fault details on the LCD display.</p> <p>The <b>FAULT</b> LED will remain on. Call your Service provider to inspect, log and rectify the fault.
